- Biomass derived carbons for **soil amendment**
- Sequential **biochar systems**

How the webinar works

- Sessions will take place on Thursday afternoons at 3 pm Central European Time / 2 pm British Time Zone.
- 2 presentations á 25 min per session followed by a short discussion.
- The webinar will use the 'Zoom' platform - <https://zoom.us/join> - a free of charge application for video conferences. The application allows to share your presentation live with participants. Online tutorials are available on YouTube.
- Interested participants only require a link to join the presentation, which will be distributed via the registration e-mail list.
- The lectures will be recorded and uploaded to a dedicated YouTube channel to increase the visibility and audience beyond the live sessions.

Audience

- The audience is expected to consist mainly of academics
- Webinar invitations will be distributed per e-mail lists of participating research groups
- The Green Carbon network will be utilised to promote the series to interested academics and the public
- The webinar series will also be promoted in relevant organisations (e.g. IBI) and conferences (e.g. Biochar II)
- The recorded presentations will be uploaded on a YouTube channel to increase the audience

The webinar series is organised by the UK Biochar Research Centre at the University of Edinburgh within the Green Carbon European Training Network - <https://www.biochar.ac.uk/>

The Green Carbon network consists of 14 PhD research projects across 8 European Universities. The network promotes collaboration between research groups focussed on environmental applications for advanced carbon materials such as biochar, hydrochar or activated carbon.
