INDUSTRY CAMPAIGNING

- **£1bn CSR bid** crafted and then **supported by the Transport Secretary** and submitted to HM Treasury.
- The following day, the Chancellor decided to cancel the three-year CSR and instead conduct a single-year Spending Review (SR).
- Focus then shifted to identifying any opportunities to cement the sector's role in green recovery, and the **'ten point' plan** for a green industrial revolution was identified.
- This resulted in **£20m new funding** being announced, and the Prime Minister committing to supporting maritime decarbonisation within the strategy. Also funding for offshore wind and hydrogen.

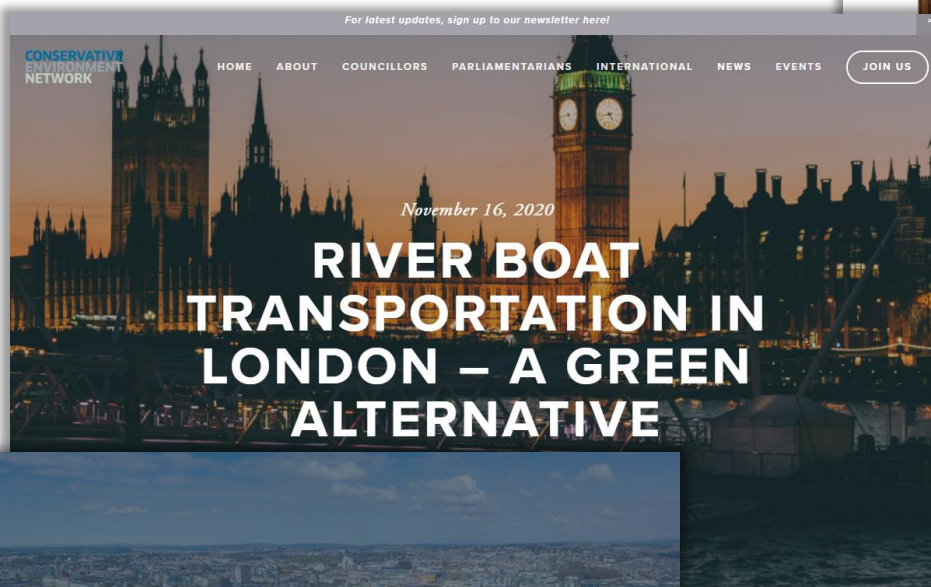
